Kahu, Maori for Harrier Hawk, inspired the name for Gerald and Juliet Hensley's neighbouring vineyard and the luscious dessert wine grown there. Squeeze of lime, ripe nectarine and rich lemon-honey aromas make this a delectable after-dinner drop, lovely with a citron tart, or the classic combination of blue cheese, a few nuts and a slice of fresh, creamy pear.,

Around 130 g/l residual sugar.
