2011

The 2011 Kahu has intense aromas of mandarin, butterscotch, apricot and melon overlaid with hints of hazelnut. The palate is rich, full and velvety with hints of spicy tamarind. The tight finish with a residual sugar of 120g/l results in a rich but fresh expression of Ali's favourite wine! Kahu makes a lovely after-dinner drop, delicious with the classic combination of blue cheese, a few nuts and a slice of fresh, creamy pear.

Serve chilled. 375 ml bottles
